

Plato Township-Board of Trustees Meeting-----May 26, 2026

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor McMahon@ 6:00 PM

ROLL CALL-Supervisor McMahon, Trustee Hulke, Trustee Myers, Trustee Wallace, Trustee Wessel and Clerk Straub- All present

-Road Commissioner Trainor and Assessor Binz- Not present

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all attending.

Citizens to be heard tonight were deferred to later in the meeting, to allow more time to speak.

Approval of the Minutes-

Trustee Wallace made a motion to approve the April 28, 2026 Board Meeting minutes, seconded by Trustee Hulke. Voice vote followed, the motion carried.

Kane County Sheriff Report-

A recent car fire was mentioned by the RR tracks- no details at this time.

Trustees Wallace and Hulke expressed concerns about the traffic now that the detour for the bridge was in place.

Trustee Wallace asked about the Sheriff placing speed control trailers and locations of same. This is in progress and reviewed by the Department.

Supervisors Report-

- A. Supervisor McMahon mentioned Arena Renewables is looking to buy land for solar 40K/ acre per the flyers they are distributing to area land owners.
- B. Supervisor McMahon renewed for May of 2026 as the motorcycle awareness month (May) making an official proclamation- presented to an Abate representative attending.
- C. Supervisor McMahon outlined the action and results of Little Rock Township at a Town Meeting.
- D. The Town Hall project will be continuing . Exploring grants and a meeting with Williams Architects May 28th to go over renderings. This will be shared at our June meeting. Trustee Hulke mentioned the lack of sewer and water services would restrict the flexibility of a new building.
- E. Lights are on at the Park/lots.
- F. Supervisor McMahon mentioned Resolution 2026-002 (Freedom250). This to be reviewed further brought to the next meeting.
- G. Supervisor McMahon stated: State Rep Dan Ugaste will be at Plato Township Supervisors Office on Tuesday June 16, 2026— 1pm to 3pm-for questions and concerns.
- H. Kane 15- Candidates David Young and Kate Monteleone were presented to the Board and both candidates gave a brief presentation on their campaign agenda, focus and thoughts . They also answered a few questions from the Board.

- I. Supervisor McMahon indicated the budget will not be completed and presented to the Board till the June meeting.
- J. Supervisor's meeting May 20th topics were reviewed. Health insurance possible solutions, IT security, AI adoption, financial and admin challenges, community and infrastructure initiatives, and public safety/inter-agency relations—were all discussed
- K. Supervisor McMahon went over the financials and answered questions. A motion to approve the warrants and financial reports subject to audit was made by Trustee Hulke and seconded by Trustee Myers seconded. Roll call vote(5- yes/ 0- no/) motion carried.
- L. Current total assets for the Township are \$1,226,476.93, Current total assets for the Road Fund are \$1,238,359.88

Highway Commissioner's Report-

No written report was provided by Road Commissioner Trainor.

Assessor's Report-

Assessor Binz provided a written report outlining that he had been taking phone calls about upcoming assessments. He indicated the 2026 books are nearly completed and due June 15,/2026.

His office is also looking into new software for operation , and reviewing solar farms and cell towers on the tax roles.

Citizens to be Heard

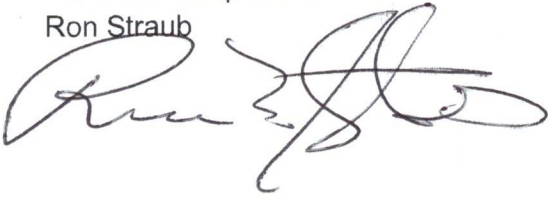
David Young asked questions regarding the fire department of the tax bill and what would be happening on the bridge replacement.
