

Plato Township-Board of Trustees Meeting-----February 24, 2026

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor McMahon@ 6:00 PM

ROLL CALL-Supervisor McMahon, Trustee Hulke, Trustee Myers, Trustee Wallace, Trustee Wessel, Assessor Binz and Clerk Straub- All present
-Road Commissioner Trainor- Not present

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all attending.

No Citizens to be heard tonight.

Approval of the Minutes-

Trustee Myers made a motion to approve the January 27, 2025 Board Meeting minutes, seconded by Trustee Wessel. Voice vote followed, the motion carried.

Kane County Sheriff Report-

No report given

Supervisors Report-

- A. The issues with the street lights in the Park are still pending. Ray's Electric(the original installer) needs to coordinate /get access to work on the lights.
- B. Annual audit engagement letter for \$11,550 was discussed. Trustee Hulke made a motion to permit signing of letter and Supervisor McMahon seconded -voice vote/ motion carried. The cost is to be part of the new Fiscal Year budget.
- C. Township was notified that the Dog Park on Plank Rd. is opening next week.
- D. General Assistance & Emergency Assistance was discussed. Mike had a recent resident request that eventually fell apart. It was noted that a current operating plan or written policy needs to be found or created. Supervisor McMahon indicated that he was planning to change to use of St Charles Township for help(IGA) in General Assistance matters rather than Elgin Township, as we have in the past for GA matters
- E. Comcast service/billing is an issue still after 3 months of conversations. Comcast billing will be further addressed by the Supervisor.
- F. Andrew Dogan with Williams Architects made a presentation on our new Town Hall project. He presented a proposal including project background, project scope, site evaluation, document review and space needs analysis and approximate costs of same. The Board will consider the proposal further next month.
- G. Supervisor McMahon went over the financials and answered questions. A motion to approve the warrants and financial reports subject to audit was made by Trustee Wallace and seconded by Trustee Myers seconded. Roll call vote(5- yes/ 0- no/) motion carried.
- H. Current total assets for the Township are \$1,314,679.88, Current total assets for the Road Fund are \$1,342,752.09

Highway Commissioner's Report- .

A written report was provided by Road Commissioner Trainor.(Trustee Wessel read it to the Board) Topics of :Muirhead Rd bridge project, 2026 resurfacing,solar/utility work , and patching/road work were addressed.

Assessor's Report-

Assessor Binz indicated he had been re-evaluating values for all commercial properties in the Township. He also has been updating any extra/ add on items on existing properties The Assessor mentioned they have 39 new properties to measure and assess also.

Clerk's Report- I presented the Board with a notice and agenda for the Annual Town Meeting.

They reviewed and amended the draft as needed.

It was approved for posting as amended. The Annual Town Meeting is to be on April,7 2026 @ 6:01 pm.(see attached draft)

Old Business –

- A. Action on the Cemetery issues is basically tabled due to illness. It will be continued at next month's Board meeting.

New Business

It was noted that a property on the corner of Corron and McDonald seems to have a shooting range of some sort- set up. This was noted by a resident. We will be keeping eye on what is going on there in the future / forward
